Applications for Readmission are reviewed by the Faculty Committee on College Readmissions. Upon review of your application, the committee may require letters of reference from professors and/or employers. The results of the review will be communicated to you at least four weeks in advance of the intended quarter of return. The College is not obliged to approve applications for readmission.
