### **Short Answer Questions**

*Responses should be kept to 200 words or less.*

1. What are two qualities that a successful O-Team member should possess? Please provide an example on how you exemplify those qualities.
2. Describe a group or team you have participated in, highlighting what you valued about that community and how you contributed to it.
3. What experiences or opportunities have motivated you to apply for this position?

### **Video Submission**

Introduce yourself and respond to ONE of the prompts:

**Prompt 1: Describe how you would create a supportive and welcoming environment at UChicago.** Focus on the specific actions, attitudes, or activities you would use to help students from different backgrounds feel comfortable, included, and connected. Explain why fostering this environment is important to you and how it reflects your values as a Student Leader.

**Prompt 2: Imagine designing a "first-week survival kit" for new students.** What three items, pieces of advice, or traditions would you include, and why? Describe how each would help students feel prepared, confident, and engaged as they start their UChicago journey. Explain how you would use this kit or the ideas behind it to make your first interactions with students memorable and meaningful.

Videos should be no longer than 3 minutes and should be delivered in a professional manner, but should reflect the individual personality, interests, abilities, etc. of the candidate. Be creative and have fun with it! File types can be **MOV, MP4, or AVI** and can be recorded using your mobile device, laptop, desktop, iPad, etc.
