# Tuesday, September 24<sup>th</sup> & Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup>

Move-in begins at 8 AM each day. Students are asked to adhere to their move-in appointment and arrive no more than 15 minutes before their appointment time.

# **GETTING TO RENEE GRANVILLE-GROSSMAN**

### FROM LAKE SHORE DRIVE

Exit at 57th Drive (Museum of Science and Industry)

Continue onto **South Cornell Avenue**, past the first two traffic signals

Veer right onto the westbound Midway Plaisance

After approximately 1 mile, turn **left** on **South Cottage Grove Avenue** Turn **left** at the second traffic signal on **60**<sup>th</sup> **street** 

Join the end of the queue and proceed to the corner of **60**<sup>th</sup> and **Ellis** Follow unloading instructions on next page

#### FROM INDIANA

Take the I-65 North or I-80 West to the Skyway (I-90/I-94 W)

Drive westbound on the Skyway, exiting at **Stony Island Avenue**, **exit 105** Drive north on **Stony Island Avenue**, and continue to **Midway Plaisance** Turn **Ieft** to enter **Midway Plaisance** 

After approximately 1 mile, turn **left** on **South Cottage Grove Avenue** Turn **left** at the second traffic signal on **60**<sup>th</sup> **street** 

Join the end of the queue and proceed to the corner of **60**<sup>th</sup> and **Ellis** *Follow unloading instructions on next page* 





# FROM THE DAN RYAN EXPRESSWAY (I-94)

Take exit 57 to Garfield Blvd/55th Street, and drive east

Go past Martin Luther King Jr Drive and continue onto Morgan Drive


Keep driving right (south) and continue onto Payne Drive

Turn left at the uncontrolled intersection

Turn right on Cottage Grove Avenue

Turn left at 60th Street

Join the end of the queue and proceed to the corner of **60**<sup>th</sup> and **Ellis** Follow unloading instructions below



## UNLOADING

To facilitate a smooth and orderly flow into the building, vehicles will be lined up and students will be able to unload in the order in which they arrive. Ellis Avenue will be blocked off between 60<sup>th</sup> and 61<sup>st</sup> Streets during move-in – the only way to enter the street is to wait in the queue of vehicles on 60<sup>th</sup> Street. The vehicle line will extend from 60<sup>th</sup> Street and may stretch several blocks, but the line will continue to move along to get each vehicle to the nearest drop-off area.

Taxis and rideshare vehicles *should not* wait in the car queue on 60<sup>th</sup> Street, but instead should be directed to drop off passengers on the corner of 61<sup>st</sup> Street and Ellis Avenue. Taxis and rideshare vehicles coming from the airport should follow the directions above via I-94 but turn from Cottage Grove Avenue onto 61<sup>st</sup> Street. Proceed three blocks east to Ellis Avenue, where you can exit the vehicle.

# **UPON ARRIVAL**

Be prepared to share the name of the House where you will be living – there are two drop-off areas and you will be directed to the closest one. In addition to helping, you move your belongings, Housing & Residence Life staff will be around to answer questions and provide general assistance.

# PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

After unloading your belongings, you will be instructed to immediately move your vehicle to make room for the next arriving student. The following University parking lots/garage will be open, free of charge, on Tuesday & Wednesday:

- Campus North Ellis Garage: 55th Street and Ellis Avenue
- Chaplin Hall Lot: S Dorchester Avenue, between 60th and 61st Streets
- Dorchester Lot: S Dorchester Avenue, between 60th and 61st Streets
- Wells Lot: Address: 60th Street and S Drexel Avenue
- Community Lot: 60th Street and Stoney Island Avenue

Continuous University shuttle service (UGo) will be offered between 8 AM – 7 PM both Tuesday & Wednesday between remote parking lots and various campus locations.

Street parking may be available in the surrounding area, including the Midway (59<sup>th</sup>) however, be mindful of parking restrictions that will be posted to avoid ticketing or towing of your vehicle. Please be patient, as the area will be more crowded than usual due to move-in.
