Our select <u>direct enrollment opportunities</u> allow you to complete coursework in your choice of academic areas at premier partner institutions in Austria, Chile, China, France, Germany, Great Britain and Ireland, Italy, Japan, South Korea, and Spain. The University's global centers in Paris, London, Beijing, New Delhi, and Hong Kong provide even greater connection with the people and the cities that you will come to know.

Summer is also an important opportunity for international experience through the University of Chicago, which offers financial support for your individual summer language study, research, or internship (see Summer International Travel Grants and Career Advancement's International Opportunities). Students who participate in Study Abroad or craft their own international experience are often excellent candidates for Rhodes, Marshall, and Fulbright awards that feature post-graduate study and research abroad.
